

In the realm of Digital Health, NABH introduced India's first Digital Health Standards for hospitals. The Koita Centre for Digital Oncology (KCDO) launched a program- LEAP for EMR adoption for 300+ NCG hospitals in cancer care. We are also pleased to share that the centre at IIT Bombay, Koita Centre for Digital Health (KCDH) is getting significant traction in its academic programs and research, with four PhD scholars receiving the prestigious Prime Minister's Research Fellowship (PMRF). We are excited to announce the launch of the Koita Centre for Digital Health at Ashoka University (KCDH-A). We also supported NHA launch a Chatbot for driving adoption of ABDM by offering capacity building to healthcare professionals.

Our NGO transformation efforts are helping our NGO partners experience significant growth. Vipla Foundation's work has been adopted by BMC in over 800 Balwadis in Mumbai. Meanwhile, CEQUE Foundation expanded to new districts with the aid of technology. We continued to extend our support to additional NGOs. KSWA and Avanti Fellows recently went live on their new tech platforms.

Digital Health Initiatives

National Accreditation Board of Hospitals & Healthcare (NABH)

Digital Health Standards Launch

National Accreditation Board of Hospitals & Healthcare (NABH) released India's first Digital Health Standards (DHS) for Hospitals on National Patient Safety Day, 17th September, 2023 in New Delhi. Koita Foundation supported NABH in the development of these standards over the past two years.

The standards are aligned with the NABH Healthcare Standards which are adopted by over 18,000 health facilities across the country. It has also incorporated the ABDM requirements and will give an impetus to ABDM adoption.

Koita Centre for Digital Oncology (KCDO)

NCG-KCDO Oncology EMR Empanelment

NCG-KCDO empaneled six ABDM-compliant oncology-specific Electronic Medical Record (EMR) vendors after running a national RFP and a rigorous selection process. Moreover, to accelerate the adoption of EMR NCG-KCDO has launched the Leading EMR Adoption Program (LEAP). Through this initiative, government & trust NCG member centres will get support, including partial funding, to implement and adopt NCG empaneled EMRs.

In LEAP Phase 1, funding support has been completed for 4 hospitals. In Phase 2, over 20 centres are being evaluated for LEAP funding.

KCDO has a strong roadmap for 2024 which includes – building patient data interoperability, standardizing cancer KPIs & metrics, introducing telemedicine, building biobank, etc. for the 300+ NCG member centres.

ABDM WhatsApp Chatbot was launched by NHA in November 2023. The ABDM WhatsApp Chatbot includes series of videos, presentations, and other material for training healthcare professionals on ABDM in a simple and intuitive manner. Koita Foundation supported NHA in building the Chatbot as well as the library of training content used in the Chatbot.

Umang Balwadi Application Adopted by BMC

Vipla Foundation operates a flagship Balwadi program at 54 community Balwadis. It also offers mentoring support to nearly 400 BMC Balwadi teachers. Koita Foundation has partnered with Vipla Foundation since 2021 to digitally transform the Balwadi program, resulting in the successful deployment of the Umang Balwadi application across all direct and indirect Balwadis.



In September 2023, Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) adopted the Umang Balwadi app for **over 800 BMC Balwadi teachers and 15 mentors to monitor teacher performance and assess outcomes for 22,000+ students!**

Kherwadi Social Welfare Association (KSWA)

'Journey-To-Livelihood' Mobile Platform

Kherwadi Social Welfare Association (KSWA) and its flagship initiative, Yuva Parivartan (YP), provide skills training to underprivileged youth in 18 states, benefiting nearly 200,000 young individuals.

To streamline their field operations, Koita Foundation collaborated with KSWA to develop an Android-based J2L (Journey To Livelihood) platform. This platform (including a mobile app) simplifies tour planning and facilitates updating of mobilization details, resulting in improved planning, target allocation, adherence to targets, outreach, and mobilization optimization for the program.

Avanti Fellows

Telecalling Platform to Boost Student Participation

Avanti Fellows enhances STEM education for underprivileged students preparing for competitive exams like IIT JEE and NEET . They offer two key programs: one provides after-school coaching for Grade 11 and 12 students in Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas, and the other offers online home learning opportunities.

To ensure higher student participation and reduce dropouts across 20,000 online students, Avanti implemented a telecaller platform using an application built on Zoho Creator. This streamlines call prioritization, provides relevant data to callers, and boosts call efficiency. Koita Foundation helped Avanti Fellows in technology selection, application design, development and roll-out.

CEQUE

Seekhein Sikhayein App

CEQUE focuses on coaching teachers from government and low-income schools, improving student learning in reading, writing, and math (grades 1-8). They operate in 8 districts across Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh, impacting 2,500 teachers and 33,000 children.

With Koita Foundation's assistance, they redesigned field visit planning and data capture using a customized android app (Seekhein Sikhayein) for coaches and district managers, enhancing field worker efficiency and monitoring capabilities. This enabled CEQUE to have a more scalable platform and expand to more districts within a year of implementing the app.

Project Abhilasha

Skilling & Employability

Koita Foundation in collaboration with Navgurukul, Vidya Bhavan Society and Bajaj FinServ, supported the launch of 'Abhilasha' in Udaipur, Rajasthan.

Abhilasha is a 15-month program to empower young girls from 14 districts of Rajasthan with software programming skills. The first batch of 100 girls will be trained and placed in leading software companies. Subsequent batches will be scaled up based on the success of the program.
