The past 6 months have been very exciting at Koita Foundation. We inaugurated our new office at Lower Parel in Mumbai in April 2023 and have grown our team. Koita Centre for Digital Health (KCDH) also moved to its new office wing at IIT Bombay and organized a national symposium on Catalyzing the Digital Health Revolution in India. We signed a MOU with Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS) to support their Digital Health initiatives including co-developing the Digital Health curriculum for 1,00,000+ medical students in Maharashtra. We supported National Accreditation Board for Hospitals (NABH) to draft and release the first version of Digital Health Standards for Hospitals.

We have continued working with NGOs in areas of education, health and livelihood to help them to use technology as a strategic tool to enhance impact and scale. Several NGOs such as Vipla Foundation, FMCH and CEQUE have enhanced the applications to derive greater value and data insights on their programs. We are also looking at scaling some applications to the government systems to enhance reach.

KCDH New Office: The new KCDH office was inaugurated by Honourable Lt. Gen Madhuri Kanitkar (Retd) PVSM, AVSM, VSM, Vice-Chancellor, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences in presence of Prof. S. Sudarshan (Dy Director) and Prof. Ravi Gudi (Dean, Alumni & Corporate Relationship) of IIT Bombay.

Digital Health Symposium: KCDH organized a symposium titled "Catalysing Digital Health Revolution in India" attended by over 250 thought leaders, researchers, academics and entrepreneurs.

KCDH Partnerships: KCDH has established MOUs/partnerships with leading hospitals including AIIMS–Delhi, Tata Memorial, KEM, Narayana Health, Shankar Netralaya, Apollo and Max. KCDH also signed a partnership with Johns Hopkins University for joint research.

National Disease Modelling Consortium (NDMC): KCDH is collaborating with experts and disease modelers' from across the country driven NDMC. NDMC aims to generate comprehensive estimates of disease burden and the impact of vaccination and other treatment and intervention.

Digital Health Foundation Course (DHFC): In collaboration with the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS), KF is developing an open-source Digital Health Foundation Course (DHFC) specifically designed for medical students, faculty, and in-service doctors in Maharashtra. The DHFC will be administered to over 1,00,000 medical students across Maharashtra. The DHFC initiative will subsequently be extended to in-service doctors in the state.

Training & Capacity Building – KF worked with NHA on the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) training and capacity building. Our work in modules videos for doctors have been uploaded on the NHA website.

KF has assisted NHA with the development of a range of informative Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) materials including posters, interactive flipcharts, handy foldables, and informative flyers. Collaborating with ABDM Partners- KF is actively collaborating with implementation partners to ensure consistent and effective communication around ABDM. KF is working with PATH, CHAI, EY, PwC, IIC, Jhpiego, etc. to support their ABDM adoption campaign and outreach efforts.

National Cancer Grid - Koita Centre for Digital Oncology (KCDO) kcdo.in

KCDO Leadership: NCG appointed Dr. Nikesh Shah as the CEO of KCDO and he joined from 3rd April 2023. NCG KCDO also constituted a strong Advisory Board with international and Indian based cancer and technology experts. To know more about them click: <u>www.kcdo.in/leadership/</u>

NCG-KCDO & NABH Digital Health MOU: NCG-KCDO signed an MOU with NABH to collaborate on digital health initiatives for cancer care. NCG-KCDO organized a successful industry consultation event, attended by over 100 experts in digital health and oncology.

NCG EMR initiative: In a first-of-its-kind initiative towards integrated cancer care, NCG plans to assist NCG hospitals in selecting, deploying, and meaningfully using oncology specific Electronic Medical Record (EMR) systems, along with the use of ABDM for data interoperability. NCG experts and technology professionals created a comprehensive set of NCG EMR requirements (NER) for cancer care. The <u>NER 2.0</u> was published in March 2023. KCDO is currently empaneling 4-6 EMR vendors for the 300+ NCG hospitals.



National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare Organizations (NABH)



NABH Digital Health Standards for Hospitals: NABH released the first draft of the NABH Digital Health Accreditation Standards. For KF, it has been truly gratifying to have worked with NABH over the past 18 months in supporting this lighthouse initiative in Digital Health. See the draft <u>NABH Digital Health Standard for Hospitals</u> released in April 2023.

The NABH Digital Health standards will help guide hospitals, healthcare technology companies, and healthcare insurance companies, and enable them to create a consistent digital roadmap across India. NABH is working closely with hospitals to support their digital health plans and help them in achieving the NABH Digital Health Accreditation.

NABH WhatsApp Chatbot: KF supported NABH with their first ever WhatsApp chatbot which will facilitate engagement between NABH and over 15,000 hospitals clients.
